

EOGH to issue college awards

Two area students will be awarded scholarships during June when officials within the auxiliary unit at East Orange General Hospital present its spring luncheon.

During its second spring luncheon June 19 at noon in the gymnasium of East Orange Campus High School, the auxiliary will award \$1,000 scholarships to incoming college students who plan to pursue degree programs.

The 2010-2011 scholarship winners are:
