EAST ORANGE GENERAL HOSPITAL CELEBRATES NATIONAL NUTRITION MONTH AND SOCIAL WORK MONTH

East Orange, N.J., March 7, 2011- March 1st kicked off the observances for both National Nutrition Month and Social Work Month. Each year, East Orange General Hospital staff commemorates the importance of both. On Friday, February 18 and Sunday, February 20, East Orange General Hospital staff and volunteers distributed coats to East Orange and surrounding community members. The coat giveaway event is an annual mainstay of the Hospital and it is often the *only* opportunity for community members to obtain a coat. “The coats could not have come at a better time”, said Kevin Slavin, President and CEO at EOGH. “We are still in a midst of an economic downturn coupled with a particularly harsh winter and East Orange General Hospital takes pride in sharing resources with our community members”. For both days, East Orange General Hospital staff and volunteers distributed over 500 coats, articles of clothing and shoes.

Jersey Cares, a non-profit, community-based organization that helps individuals, families and community groups was able to donate 2,000 coats in all sizes to East Orange General Hospital. This year marks the fourth year that East Orange General Hospital (EOGH) partnered with Jersey Cares for its annual “Community Coat Pick-Up Day”. In addition to distributing coats directly to community members, EOGH also provided 1400 coats to local community and civic-based organizations and local churches.

“Every year, East Orange General Hospital staff members prepare themselves for the Annual Coat Giveaway. Telephone inquiries from community members start coming in as early as September, when we are hosting our Annual Minority and Multicultural Health Fair”, said Leslie Eaddy, Director of Community Outreach.
