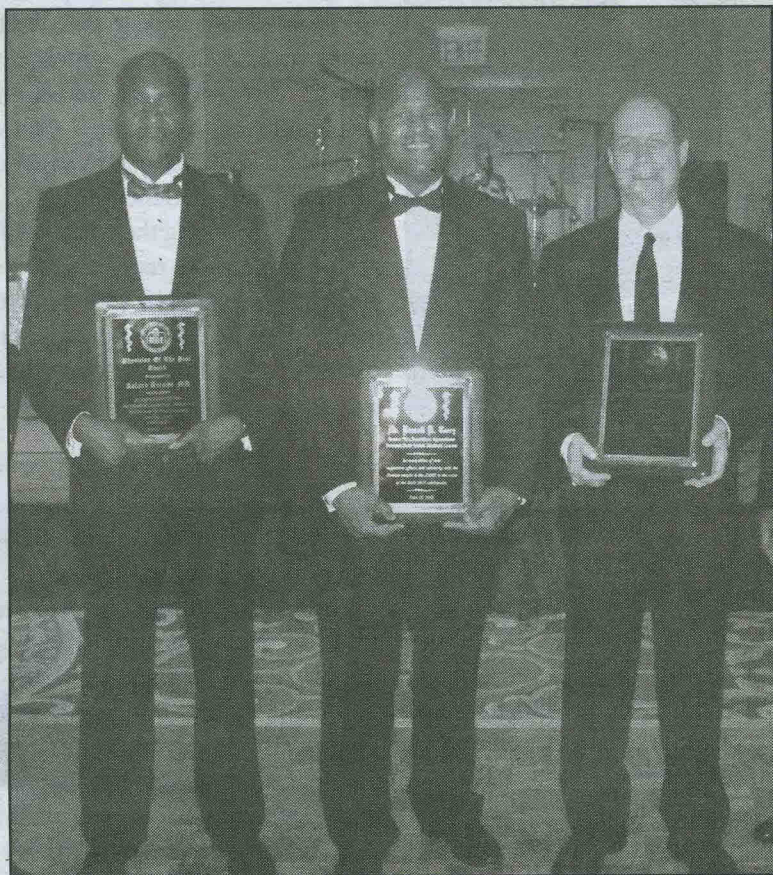


Trio of Health Care Professionals Honored for Haitian Relief Efforts
