



As part of our Coronavirus response, East Orange General Hospital is restricting all visitation effective Friday, March 13th.

At East Orange General Hospital, there is no greater priority than the health and safety of our patients, visitors, and staff.

COVID-19 is a novel virus that poses an unprecedented threat to our patients, especially those who are elderly, have underlying medical conditions or have compromised immune systems. As coronavirus concerns escalate quickly, New Jersey's hospitals and health systems have partnered with the New Jersey Hospital Association to expand standardized visitor restrictions. These precautions include:

- ▶ **No hospital visitors will be allowed until further notice.**
- ▶ Limited exceptions include:
 - ▶ Patients in hospice or end-of-life care
 - ▶ One visitor/support person for an individual undergoing same-day surgery or an ambulatory procedure.

Visitors who meet these exceptions will be screened for symptoms before being allowed to visit.
