

UPDATED VISITOR POLICY

EOGH continues to prioritize the safety and well-being of our patients, visitors and staff. We continue to evaluate our visitation policy in an effort to minimize the risk of spread of COVID-19.

Effective **December 1st** our current visitation level is: **Red – No Visitors**

Exceptions to the policy is listed below.

VISITATION EXCEPTIONS (ALL MUST BE APPROVED BY CARE TEAM)

RED LEVEL GUIDANCE

| Emergency Department | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One parent or one guardian of pediatric patients for the duration of stay • One visitor, must be same person, for patients with intellectual, developmental, or other cognitive disability for the duration of stay |
| Surgery/Procedure Patients | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provided social distancing can be accomplished, one visitor until patient is taken into prep. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Visitor must then leave ○ Visitor may not be present during procedures or in the recovery room; except for patients with intellectual, developmental, or other cognitive disability. |
| Adult In-Patient | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One visitor at discharge for bedside discharge directions and education |
| Psychiatry | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Permission to visit must be approved by care team in advance of visit, including time and duration of visit |
| End of Life | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Up to two visitors at a time |

▶ All visitors, if approved, must:

- must be age 18 years or older.
- be screened upon entry for symptoms of illness
- maintain social distancing guidelines and wear a face mask at all times.
